HELPING YOU SPREAD THE WORD

To help you get your school* community excited, we've made some support materials for you. You can use these around your school* grounds, in your newsletters and during school* assemblies. These include:

- Five Collection Boxes
- Five Recyclable Collection Box Liners
- Four A4 Posters (2 to be put up at the start of the program and 2 to be put up at the start of Term 3)
- Four A3 Posters (2 to be put up at the start of the program and 2 to be put up at the start of Term 3)
- Twenty A4 Certificates

GETTING THE PROGRAM SET UP IN YOUR SCHOOL*

1. Set up your Collection Box

- Assemble and set up your first Collection Box as soon as it arrives. Don't forget to add the Recyclable Collection Box Liner
- We suggest you set up one box up at a time in a location that is easy for students to see and access

NB – You can collect bread bags up until 9th September, 2022.

2. Fill your Collection Boxes

It's now time to start collecting bread bags! To help you do this we've created some ready-to-use support materials. All support materials can be found in the welcome email.

- Each Collection Box can be filled with 5kgs of bread bags (*if you don't have scales that's about 14-16 Wonder bread bags filled with bread bags or wraps packs*)



**Collect and weigh

3. Drop off at Australia Post for recycling

- As soon as a Collection Box is full you can post it off for recycling. Simply seal the Recyclable Box Liner within the Collection Box by folding over the top (without using sticky tape) then close your box securely shut
- Go to return.auspost.com.au/wonderrecyclingrewards (you can also find this link in your school account) and enter your school address to generate a FREE return label for you to attach to your collection box. Make sure you request and keep a tracking label from the post office for free so we can track any lost boxes (and rewards points!) for your school

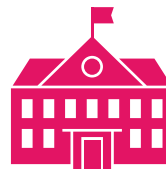
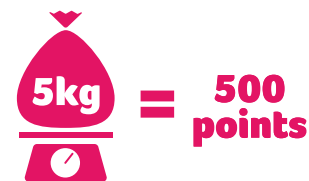


REWARDS POINTS

How are the reward points allocated?

Once your Collection Boxes arrive at our recycling partner (REDcycle), they will weigh your bread bags and record the weight. This information will then be supplied to RHSports who will allocate the rewards points to your unique Wonder Recycling Rewards account.

You can review your tally during the collection period by logging into your Wonder Recycling Rewards RHSports account. You can also check out all the sports equipment on offer and start building your RHSports wish list at rhsports.com.au/wonderrecyclingrewards



Each school* can collect up to 2,500 points!!

How do we earn more points if the boxes have all been used?

If you find your school* collects in excess of FIVE Collection Boxes (more than 25kg), and you wish to continue collecting and recycling, email us on wonder@rhsports.com.au and we will post additional Collection Boxes** to support your amazing recycling efforts. Bags collected over 25kg won't earn you more reward points but you will get a massive thumbs up from the environment! The return postage on any additional boxes requested will need to be paid for by the school*. Additional boxes will have your school's* unique code on them so we will be able track and report your school's* outstanding performance.

** While Collection Box stock lasts.

Do we get points for recycling the bread bag tags?

We will only be rewarding points for bread bags collected to keep rewards points even and fair.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Repeat the above steps with each of your five boxes. **Five boxes (25kgs) is the maximum amount each school* can collect**
- Once the campaign is finished please recycle any unused Collection Boxes
- At the end of the campaign we will let you know your recycling tally and your school's* total number of reward points you have earned
- Don't forget to visit rhsports.com.au/wonderrecyclingrewards throughout the campaign to stay up to date with your school's* rewards points
- From **10th October** you can add items to your cart to build your wish list
- Rewards points need to be **redeemed in ONE order between 10th October and 21st October** on the RHSports website
- Sports equipment will be delivered to schools* from 4 weeks of processing your order, however please note it will take longer (up to 3 months) for any popular items that have to be restocked. RHSports will process all orders and arrange delivery to your school*. **There is no delivery fee**
- To see our full terms and conditions please visit wonder.com.au
- Sports equipment orders will be supplied on a first come, first served basis. RHSports will do their best to source more of the most popular items, but this will be at their discretion and availability. All stock enquiries need to be sent to wonder@rhsports.com.au. The official window of delivery for sports equipment is between 24th October to 23rd December, 2022
- The supply and installation of the recycled REPLAS exercise circuit will be organised by Wonder directly with the winning school*

NB – Wonder will liaise with the winning school* to determine the best installation date for the REPLAS exercise circuit

TWO RECYCLING REMINDERS

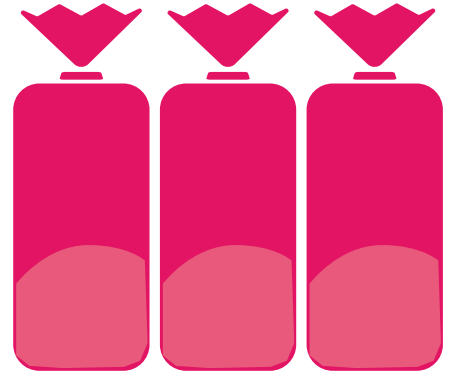
It's important that items being recycled are not contaminated with other products and are as clean as possible. Here's a quick checklist for you:

What is a bread bag for recycling purposes?

The rule of thumb is that if it has contained bread of some sort and is a soft plastic, then it's a bread bag. If it hasn't contained bread, then it's not a bread bag.

How clean do the bags have to be?

Bread bags should be free from crumbs to ensure no contamination during the recycling process but they do not need to be washed.
